

2026 Blue Ridge Trail Golf League Agreement

To clarify golf course policies, Blue Ridge Trail Golf Course will implement and enforce an updated set of written regulations concerning league play for the 2026 season and beyond. Before the commencement of league play, each organizer must sign, date, and distribute the following policies to the players in their leagues. League play will not be authorized before the signing of this document.

General Rules:

- Clubhouse Hours: The clubhouse will be open from 6 am to 9 pm Sunday through Friday. Alcohol will be served in the clubhouse and on the course from 8 am to 9 pm Monday through Saturday and from 9 am to 9 pm on Sundays.
- League Rate Policy: Members of leagues will be offered their league rate of play for 9 holes Monday through Friday after 3 pm. League rates are **not** honored on Weekends.

Updated Policies:

1. Rain Check Policy: In the case of forecasted potential rain, a slip from the pro shop will be issued to the player which must be signed and time-stamped by the starters, prior to the start of the round. (The slip can only be signed when all players in the group are ready to start) Once the slip is signed, a **one-hour** rain check policy begins. From that moment forward, it is up to the discretion of the player to decide what to do. Players always have the option to wait out the rain in the pro shop or collect the rain check prior to the one-hour mark. To receive a raincheck, players must return the signed, time-stamped slip to the pro shop. **Players must have their slips to collect their rainchecks.** Additionally, players must present their rain check redemption slip when returning to play. If the slip is lost the raincheck is no longer valid, no exception. Any players going out for warmup holes will be signed at that time and the policy will initiate.
2. Warmup Hole Policy: Warmup holes before rounds are a privilege provided to the leagues by Blue Ridge Trail Golf Course and are in no way a right or guarantee. Moving forward, the warmup holes policy will be as follows: league players are allowed a maximum of 4 warmup holes **which must take place prior to the start of their league round.** Players intending on playing warmup holes **must see the starters prior to going out.** Additional holes played after rounds will be considered theft of services and will not be permitted outside of special circumstances. (ex. Playoff holes) Players found violating this policy will be issued a warning and further violation will result in the revoking of warmup holes for all players of the individual league. Players found to be violating this policy on multiple occasions will be asked to leave their league.
3. Alcohol Policy: There will be a zero-tolerance policy for outside alcohol on the property. Outside alcohol is a violation of our PA liquor license and Blue Ridge Trail staff reserves

the right to confiscate all alcohol purchased off the property. Additionally, alcohol consumption in the parking lot after rounds is not permitted under any circumstances.

Note: Each individual is responsible for themselves under the actions written within the alcohol policy.

The Blue Ridge Trail Golf Course staff look forward to another great season with all of our returning leagues. When this is returned, signed and dated by the organizer, it shares with our staff that the contract has been shared with the entirety of the league.
